Joint Resolution to endorse "Warning to Humanity"

Whereas there is collective scientific evidence of our rapidly declining global environment and climate;

Whereas the evidence is reported in the document "World Scientists' Warning to Humanity: A Second Notice" (Ripple, et al., 2017)

Whereas twenty thousand scientists from 184 countries worldwide have endorsed the findings of these scientific conclusions;

Whereas the effects of Earth's biosphere decline will impact all people, cultures, and economies; and

Whereas the educational and research missions of Oregon State University have significant interests and commitments to work to minimize those negative impacts; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the Faculty Senate and Associated Students of Oregon State University

- 1. jointly endorse the "World Scientists' Warning to Humanity: A Second Notice"; and
- 2. urge University leadership and all parts of the OSU community to advance dialogue, policies, and practices in accordance with the recommendations of that document.
