As I was reviewing a syllabus on Tuesday and checking links I discovered the link we currently use <http://oregonstate.edu/studentconduct/offenses-0> now goes to a pdf for "Oregon State University Code of Student Conduct." Originally, this link sent a student directly to the Offenses pages on the Student Conduct website.

I contacted Willie Morgan, Assistant Director Operations, Office of Student Life. Speaking with Willie, I discovered they have been redesigning the website for Student Life and AR 15. Academic Misconduct. AR 15 was brought to the Faculty Senate on May 11, 2017, see Faculty Senate Agenda. This revision was approved and went into effect September 11, 2017.

The Office of Academic Programs and Assessment is requesting the **Syllabus – Minimum Requirements** be adjusted to reflect the new link <http://studentlife.oregonstate.edu/code> for the University's use. We would like to change the Website section "Statement of Expectations for Student Conduct" by removing the currently link <http://oregonstate.edu/studentconduct/offenses-0> and adding right below, the sentence "USE: <http://studentlife.oregonstate.edu/code> "

Currently it reads: "**Link to Statement of Expectations for Student Conduct**, i.e., cheating policies" (with a hyperlink <http://oregonstate.edu/studentconduct/offenses-0> )

To Read with no hyperlink: "**Statement of Expectations for Student Conduct**, i.e., cheating policies

USE: <http://studentlife.oregonstate.edu/code> "

So the Course Syllabi remain in compliance with Faculty Senate decisions, I request the changes to this policy be placed on the upcoming agenda for the Committee. Once the Curriculum Council has approved these revisions, I would be very happy to update the policy and implement this change on all future syllabi.
