

Faculty Senate OSU Presidential Search Ad Hoc Committee

Charge:

- Following the [Resolution](#) passed by the Faculty Senate on April 8, your task is to develop a set of guidelines and recommendations for the upcoming OSU Presidential Search.
- These guidelines and recommendations will be shared with the Faculty Senate and be presented for approval at the June 10 meeting. As with all presentations to the Senate, the Executive Committee can provide useful suggestions on your presentation. Tuesday, June 1 would be the best day for this. Regardless, you need to provide your ppt and document to send with the Senate meeting agenda no later than Noon on June 4.
- A [preliminary list of best practices and recommendations](#) was developed by members of the Faculty Senate Executive Committee in March, and may serve as a starting point for your work, if you so choose.
- A chair or co-chairs of the committee shall be identified by the Task Force to facilitate communication with the Senate office.
- Representatives of the Task Force shall meet with the Board of Trustees on May 18.
- President Heppell will be providing a Faculty Senate report to the Board of Trustees at their final meeting of AY21 on May 21. The membership of the committee will be presented; any additional information that the committee would like to share can be sent to President Heppell in advance of that meeting.
