

NIH Data Management and Sharing Policy 2023

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Issued on October 29, 2020, the [NIH Policy for Data Management and Sharing](#) aims to promote the management and sharing of scientific data generated from NIH-funded or conducted research. The policy requires the submission of a Data Management and Sharing Plan, and expects that researchers will maximize the sharing of research data (with exceptions when justified). The policy will come into effect on January 25, 2023, and will cover grant applications for the January 25, 2023 cycle and all subsequent grant cycles.

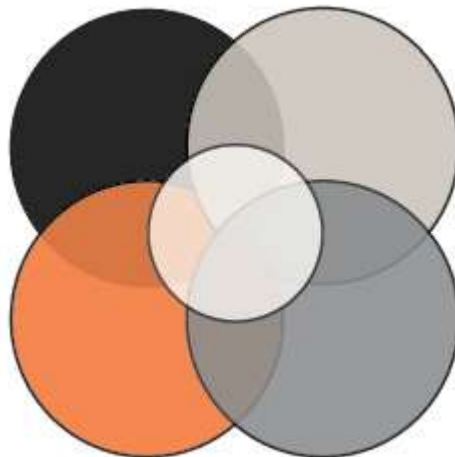
