The Academic Regulations Committee started work during the summer of 2018 to revamp all of the Academic Regulations due to feedback or issues raised by various clientele (students, advisors, etc.), and some necessary administrative changes (such as updating language). During the Fall 2018 term, the Academic Regulations Committee continued this work.

Work on updating all of the Academic Regulations continued during Winter 2019. Several of the Academic Regulations, including: Introduction, AR 2, 3, 7, 9, 10, 12, 13, 18, 19, 22, 25, 26, 29 and 31 were presented to the Faculty Senate Executive Committee for approval.

The Executive Committee approved several of the proposed Academic Regulations, which were then presented to the Faculty Senate on May 9, 2019, and the following were approved: Introduction, AR 3, 7, 9, 10, 12, 18, 22 and 25.
