## Academic Regulations Committee

### Annual Report 1999-2000

During the 1999-2000 academic year, the Academic Regulations Committee accomplished the following:

1. We considered adding the A+ grade to the list of grades that instructors could assign to students. This was in response to requests from the officers of ASOSU. We discussed this change within committee and brought it up as a discussion item with the Executive Council and the Faculty Senate. From these discussions it became clear that a consensus did not exist for a change in the grading system at this time. Therefore, the committee did not formally propose any changes.
2. We considered changes to AR10, which spells out the conditions required for student participation in intercollegiate athletics. We proposed that AR10's former section b be amended to include a simple statement that students must meet all PAC-10 and NCAA requirements. The Faculty Senate approved this proposal.
3. We mainly considered changes to AR25, section f, which sets out the number of credits that an undergraduate must complete while in residence at OSU. It was proposed that the requirement be changed from 45 of the last 60 credits to 45 of the last 75 credits to accommodate distance-education students and students in other special undergraduate programs. The Faculty Senate approved this proposal.
4. We considered changes to AR23, which formerly allowed a student to petition for credit by special examination at any time. We proposed that section d of AR23 be modified to preclude students from petitioning in any quarter in which they were enrolled in the course past the add/drop deadline for the quarter. The Faculty Senate approved this proposal, as well as some clarifications to other sections of AR23.
5. We considered changes to AR11 for extending the add/drop period. The consensus of the committee was to not propose any changes at this time.
6. We considered changes to AR12 for extending the time in which a student is able to withdraw from a course with a W grade. The consensus of the committee was to not propose any changes at this time.
