#### **Curriculum Four-Year Plans**

### **Curriculum Policies and Procedures**

A four-year curriculum plan is required with New Category I proposals and for New and Change Category II proposals. This requirement applies to all undergraduate majors and is effective Summer Term 2016 (201700). This is not a requirement for graduate programs. A four year plan of courses, term-by-term must be attached to the proposal to facilitate MyDegrees template construction and updating. (Note: For Category II proposals the four-year plan can be placed in the requirements Block and/or as an attachment to the proposal.) Courses should be listed Alpha/Numeric per term and include all necessary Baccalaureate Core course work to complete the program. The credit total should equal 180 or more for certain engineering programs.

Example:

# **Proposed revisions:**

### **Curriculum Four-Year Plans' policy:**

All academic units submitting a new undergraduate major—or changes to their major—must also submit a four-year plan for the MyDegrees planner. Four-year plans are required for each required option of the major and should clearly list the major requirements and Baccore credits required to meet the total minimum required credits for the program (most are 180).

#### **Curriculum Four-year Plan Submission Guidelines:**

- Four-year plans should be submitted within the proposal system requirements box (not as an attachment) in a year-by-year, term-by-term format (see sample below).
- Courses should be listed in the term that the academic unit believes makes the best sense for students pursuing the program.
- When listing courses in each term, they should be in alpha/numeric order by subject designator and course number with Baccore, electives, and options courses listed last.

• If the program wishes to suggest *when* students should take a required Baccore course (such as WR 121 and HHS 231), they may list those specifically in the particular term. However, this is not be required.
