Brenda, Theresa and Sujaya:

Thanks you so much for the conversation this morning regarding the possibility of restarting/reforming an interdisciplinary graduate degree in Entomology. We agreed that the approach would be to get broad engagement among the faculty with entomology expertise and the department heads and curriculum committees within their respective units and develop a Category I proposal as if it were a new degree rather than a restart. The process would include an external review team visiting OSU. Because it is a restart of a degree that is currently in the OSU catalog, it might not require approvals beyond the Provost, once we have the external review recommendations and the Cat I proposal. I will move forward to engage the entomologists in a conversation and will keep you posted as to how things are progressing.
