

~~Review of Academic Programs~~—External Review: Procedures for Proposed Graduate and Professional Programs Degrees

Proposals for new graduate and professional degrees ~~and certificates which have been approved by the OUS Provosts' Council~~ must undergo an external review prior to final approval by the ~~State Board of~~ Higher Education Coordinating Commission. The ~~department or program academic unit~~ proposing the new degree bears the cost of the review. The review committee typically must consist of a minimum of three disciplinary peers external to OSU (candidates for the review committee are submitted by the ~~department academic unit~~ in the Category I New Degree Program proposal), ~~who~~. The external review committee reviews the Category I New Degree Program proposal and all supporting documents, conducts a site visit to evaluate the adequacy of facilities and infrastructure to support the degree, and submits a report on the viability of the program. ~~See OUS Guidelines for External Reviews for more details.~~
