

# HB2998 Update

Goal: Reduce transfer student credit loss

Two major mandates:

- 1) Recommend a **Foundational Curriculum** of at least 30 credits that is fully transferable from community colleges to any state university
- 1) Determine the initial majors for which **unified statewide transfer agreements** will be established.

# Foundational Curriculum



Based in existent AAOT and OTM and previously approved learning outcomes

Uses existing AAOT learning outcomes

Each university determines how the FC articulates to its general education requirements

Not a course-by-course articulation

For CC to university transfer; no decision regarding lateral or university to CC transfers

Category	
Writing	1 course (WR121) (3-4 credits)
Arts & Letters	2 courses (6-8 credits)
Math	1 course (4-5 credits)
Social Sciences	2 courses (6-8 credits)
Natural Science	2 courses with labs (8-10 credits)
<b>Additional Requirements:</b>	At least 1 of the above courses must also meet Cultural Literacy outcomes
	<b>At Least 30 credits:</b> If the credit total for the required classes is less than 30 credits, select an additional course from the AA/OT outcome courses
<b>Total</b>	At least 8 courses (at least 30 credits)

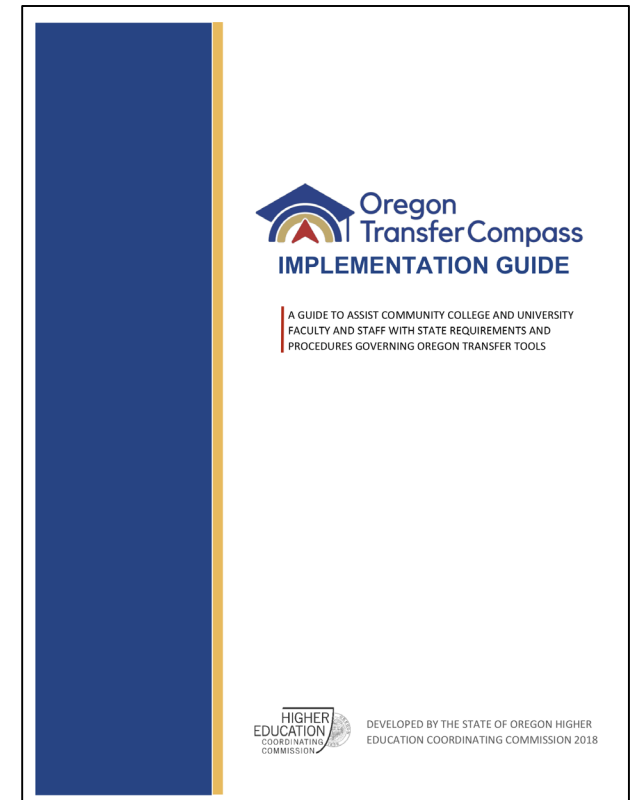
