#### Hi Chris

I have done some further research into the HUM code and after discussion with Rebecca, we think it might be best if we create a new Humanities code for you instead.

The reason for this is that HUM was never intended to be used by OSU. It was created years ago as part of the joint campus program at Cascades and it is actually a University of Oregon subject code. It was a past practice during the joint campus program for us to create subject codes in Banner for the other universities. We are worried that reactivating it now will create confusion in data reporting and as I mentioned before, the description for it will be Humanities-UO which we can't change. We are concerned about students getting the wrong impression because that description will display in the catalog. As an example, if you follow this link to our Anthropology courses, you can see the prominence of the subject code heading: <u>https://catalog.oregonstate.edu/courses/anth/</u>

I apologize for not elaborating on these issues earlier. We have taken time to assess the situation and I will admit to also being unaware of the old joint campus program and the past practices of entering UO and EOU courses into our Banner system.

Although it has been over 6 years and we will not stop you from creating new HUM courses, we strongly recommend that you create a new subject code instead. It will also be cleaner in future if you decide to offer more humanities courses, not just a few for honors students. HUMA is an available subject code and the Registrar's Office would support it at Curriculum Council.

Please let me know if you have any questions. The decision is ultimately up to you.

The last of the HUM courses were dropped in 201301 so it has been over six years but there is nothing in Banner that will stop us adding new courses under that subject code. You would just need to submit new course proposals in the <u>CPS</u>.

One thing you should be aware of is that the subject code description is 'Humanities-UO.' If new courses were established using HUM, they would appear in the catalog under that description which may be misleading. We do not change subject code descriptions because it alters our historical records.
