

## Current Hybrid Course Policy

A hybrid course includes both regularly scheduled on-site classroom meetings, and significant online out-of-classroom components, that replace regularly scheduled class meeting time.

## Proposed Hybrid Course Policy

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### Hybrid Courses

#### Hybrid Course Definition

A hybrid course integrates regularly scheduled on-site classroom instruction with online, out-of-classroom instruction. A substantial portion of the course learning activities are delivered online with less face-to-face meeting time compared to a traditional on-campus course.

- For example, a hybrid course of 3-credit hours that normally meets for two 80-minute periods each week might involve meeting on campus for one 80-minute period weekly, blended with online learning activities requiring student engagement equivalent to a second classroom meeting.
- Alternatively, a hybrid course of 3-credit hours might meet (for a weekend or evening) in person twice over the term with the rest of student learning activities delivered online.

#### Hybrid Course Components

- Students are required to participate in both the face-to-face and online portions of the course.
- Online portions of the hybrid course are provided through Canvas.
- Student learning time expected face-to-face versus online learning activities must be included in the syllabus.

#### Review Process (Implementation Procedure)

- Hybrid courses are listed in Banner SIS as a Schedule Type (HYB).
- All new hybrid courses must be submitted through the Curriculum Review Process for expedited review and approval and as a record of the change in modality

#### Hybrid Locations and Tuition Considerations

- Hybrid courses offered on the OSU-Corvallis campus are considered on-campus courses for tuition purposes.
- Hybrid courses may also be offered via Ecampus, if the face-to-face portions of the courses are offered off-campus, or outside of normal 8 am to 5 pm business hours. Hybrid courses offered via Ecampus:
  - Use the Ecampus course development process
  - Are considered Ecampus courses for tuition purposes
- All hybrid courses that meet at the Portland Center are offered via Ecampus.
- For OSU-Cascades, all hybrid courses, regardless of when they are offered, are offered at OSU-Cascades tuition.
