## **Category II Reviews**

- ART 411, WIC
  - They are adding a Cascades location but they did not provide a syllabus for the Cascades campus.
  - They need to define what the catalog essay is it is referenced frequently but they do not go into detail on what it is or what the assignment entails.
    - Send back requesting additional syllabus and a description of the catalog essay.
- BI 319
  - All three major assignments assess BC LOs one and two. Should the committee expect differentiation?
    - The WIC office has no problem with this and states that this is common practice.
  - Course numbers range from 18-29 students. Is this an issue?
    - Historically, the BCC has allowed recertification of WIC courses up to 29 students in a course. 25 is or fewer is preferred, but is not a hard restriction.
      - If the course goes over 29 students, they must add a TA or make a new section.
  - The syllabus uses old verbiage 'This course partially fulfills...' and it is not very prominently displayed on the syllabus.
    - WIC outcomes are verbatim.
      - Approve with note to move verbatim statement so it is more prominent.
