

Syllabus - Minimum Requirements

Course proposals require a syllabus* to be attached under Documents in the proposal. A syllabus is required for **all locations** (Corvallis, Cascades, Hatfield, La Grande, Portland) and **all modalities** (Ecampus, hybrid, lecture/lab) the course will be taught. Course Proposal Software submissions will require upload of all (location and modality) syllabi for the course, including when only one version (location or modality) is being added or changed. Special Topics (e.g., X99), Blanket Numbered (e.g. 401-410), and Experimental (X) courses do not require a syllabus to be attached to these proposals. Each syllabus should include the following information:
