

# **OSU Faculty Senate News**

December 5, 2022

The OSU Faculty Senate represents academic and research faculty (tenure, tenure-track and fixed-term), as well as professional faculty. There is no minimum FTE for Faculty Senate inclusion. The defined faculty ranks appear in Article III of the Bylaws at <a href="https://senate.oregonstate.edu/bylaws">https://senate.oregonstate.edu/bylaws</a>.

The purpose of the newsletter is to update faculty on upcoming opportunities and events, as well as information items related to the Faculty Senate.

### 1. November Faculty Senate Action Items

- Motion to approve: Accept the Program Inactivation Proposal (Applied Ethics Certificate, Key #128) as presented by the Curriculum Council co-chair Ping-Hung Hsieh. The motion passed with 80 votes in favor, 0 votes in opposition and 1 abstention.
- Motion to approve: Accept the New Program Proposal (Humanitarian Engineering Certificate, Key #781) as presented by the Curriculum Council co-chair Ping-Hung Hsieh. The motion passed with 78 votes in favor, 0 votes in opposition and 0 abstentions.
- Motion to approve: The 2023 Apportionment Table. The motion passed with 77 votes in favor, 0 votes in opposition and 2 abstentions.
