Student Bill of Rights

The below was incorrectly published in the February 9, 2022 Faculty Senate Newsletter. Apologies for any confusion this may have caused.

On December 9, 2021, students representing the ASOSU Office of Advocacy presented a request to the Faculty Senate to require the addition of the [Student Bill of Rights](#) on all course syllabi; Faculty Senators approved this request.

By including the Student Bill of Rights in course syllabi, students felt that it:

- Reinforces the concept of a syllabus acting as a written agreement between faculty and students
- Protects students and faculty
- Reminds faculty of their responsibility to follow their syllabus
- Improves course transparency and clarity
- Demonstrates OSU's commitment to student success
