PreK-12 English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL)

The PreK-12 English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) minor requires fifteen (15) graduate credit hours of coursework that focuses on how to effectively work with children and adolescents who are learning English as an additional language. It is designed for prekindergarten through twelfth grade (preK-12) teachers in the United States. Courses incorporate state and national learning standards for preK-12 students, as well as state and national ESOL standards for preK-12 teacher preparation programs in the areas of language, culture, instruction, assessment, and professionalism.

Candidates who wish to add the ESOL endorsement to a current Oregon teaching license need to contact the ESOL endorsement program coordinator in the College of Education regarding additional licensure requirements.
