

Post Tenure Review (PTR)

Current

Members of the PTR committee shall be elected by the unit faculty who are at or above the rank of the faculty member being reviewed. In addition, a representative from outside the unit shall be included. The external committee member shall be selected by the unit PTR committee from a list who are tenured faculty members at or above the rank of the faculty being reviewed. The list (at least three such faculty members) shall be provided by the faculty member being reviewed.

Proposed Revision

Members of the PTR committee shall be elected by the unit faculty who are at or above the rank of the faculty member being reviewed. **Retired faculty members are not eligible to serve on the PTR committee.** In addition, a representative from outside the unit shall be included. The external committee member shall be selected by the unit PTR committee from a list who are tenured faculty members at or above the rank of the faculty being reviewed. The list (at least three such faculty members) shall be provided by the faculty member being reviewed.

Rationale for Proposed Revision

This change is consistent with the current P&T guidelines. It is also consistent with general policies governing the role of emeritus faculty members and decision making.
