SUBJECT: Research Council Activities, Academic Year 1998 - 1999

The purpose of the Research Council is to promote, stimulate, and facilitate research activity at Oregon State University. The Council does this by advising the Vice Provost for Research concerning the dissemination of information, by providing advice on research policies, and by reviewing requests for funds from the General Research Fund.

During the period to date, the Research Council reviewed 153 requests for support. Of these requests, 57 were approved for funding at a total of \$999,126. The source of funds and amounts provided are indicated below.

General Research Fund (GRF): 15 awards totaling \$101,866

Research Equipment Reserves Funds (RERF): 42 awards totaling \$897,260
