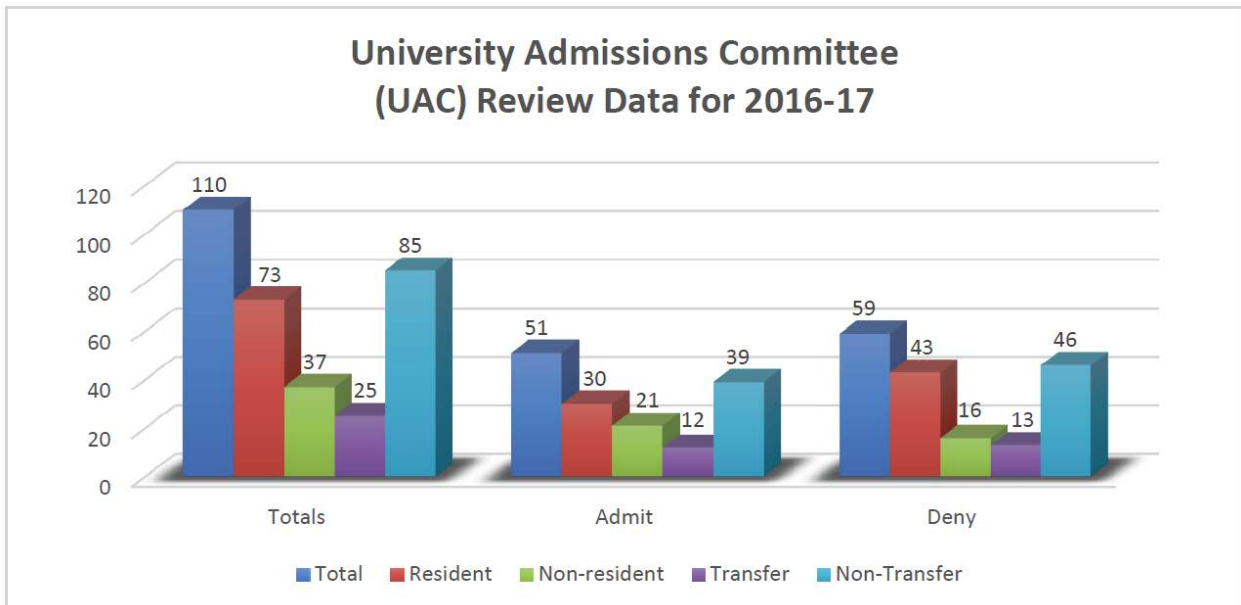
The Undergraduate Admissions Committee (UAC) met monthly beginning with the 2016 summer term and bi-weekly during the academic year. Meetings during the academic year were scheduled for two hours and generally ran less than the time allotted. Therefore, the committee met until the docket was complete.

Marilyn Stewart chaired the UAC for the 2016-17 academic year. She stepped down July 31, completing the initial obligation and an extended term and chairmanship.

- Initial meeting included review of admission appeals (Extended Admissions) procedures, SAT/ACT scores and non-traditional schools for criterion, international admission requirements, as well as best meeting days and times for academic year.
 - The appeals process was reviewed by all committee members. The committee concluded that face-to-face meetings work well for timely decisions and to continue the current process; however, cases for exception to regular meeting process may be reviewed during an electronic meeting/s.

The UAC reviewed 110 extended requests for undergraduate admission. The actual breakdown as follows: Totals applications 110, Admitted 51, Denied 59, Resident 73, Non-Resident 37, Transfer 25, Non-Transfer 85
