SUBJECT: "Urban Forest Landscapes" Option available via Ecampus

The Curriculum Council approved the option in "Urban Forest Landscapes" (proposal number 80773) on January 10, 2011, as part of the updated Natural Resources program curriculum. At that time, there was not enough coursework available via Ecampus to offer this option to our Ecampus students. Corvallis campus students have been able, since that time, to complete this option with a combination of Ecampus and Corvallis campus classes.

We now, however, have sufficient classes to offer this option to our Ecampus students, and each class has been taught at least one time via Ecampus. FOR/HORT 447 was the class we were waiting for, and it was offered for the first time Spring term, 2012. Only one course in the option (FOR 462, see class in red print on the attached document) is not available via Ecampus, but the option was designed with a course choice for that requirement.

As with our other Ecampus options, the option code will be the same for the Corvallis and Ecampus students. In the case of Urban Forest Landscapes, the option code is 685.

We are requesting approval to offer this option via Ecampus, and to have it signified as such in the General Catalog. I have included additional information requested by Gary Beach on behalf of the Curriculum Council. Please let me know if you need any clarification of the coursework involved, or the intent of this request.
