

## **Undergraduate Student Success Summit**

The purpose of the Undergraduate Student Success Summit is to engage the entire campus and partners (e.g., the OSU Foundation, INTO OSU) to advance OSU's undergraduate student success goals. Specifically, the Summit is an opportunity to:

- Focus attention on OSU's student success goals,
- Report on progress and problems with student success to the whole campus,
- Exchange student success knowledge across the whole campus and stakeholders,
- Solicit advice from staff and faculty, who are delivering student engagement and support, for central actions and policies related to student success.

The first Undergraduate Student Success Summit, held on April 12, 2018, included 309 members of the OSU community, including faculty, administrators, staff, students, and representatives from OSU-Cascades, Extended Campus, INTO OSU, and the OSU Foundation. Preliminary findings from the Undergraduate Student Success Initiative Steering Committee (USSI-SC) were shared at the summit. Summit attendees contributed insights into prioritization, both during the summit and via a follow-up survey. Following the first Summit, the USSI-SC submitted a report ( ) to the Provost. The USSI-SC continues its work to advise the Provost and engage the campus on undergraduate student success.

The second Undergraduate Student Success Summit will be held on March 7, 2019. Its goals remain the same as the first Summit. This year's format is modeled after an academic conference in which attendees propose sessions. To date, we have received approximately 30 session proposals on a wide range of student success topics. The agenda will be set by the end of the first week of February.
